



SATELLITE DISH INSTALLATION GUIDE

- Satellite dish antennas may only be installed on the “rear” balcony support post and cannot be directly visible from the front of the residence.
- Installation must be carried out by an experienced qualified installer to ensure the exterior of the building is not damaged.
- Satellite dishes are not to be larger than 21 inches in diameter as shown in the attached photo.
- Satellite dishes must be installed below the roof line of the house.
- Wiring must be run from the dish as discretely as possible to the closest point of access to the house.
- Wiring is not to be run along the exterior walls of the house.
- All holes through the building walls must be properly sealed and waterproofed to prevent water entry.
- Only one Satellite dish per residence is permitted.
- The unit owner accepts the responsibility for the maintenance and upkeep of the satellite dish and agrees to have it removed if not in use.
